Board Bylaws/Policies Committee
General Purpose

Appointments and Composition

The Board Bylaws/Policies Committee is commissioned by and responsible to the Governing Board of NPA. It shall assume the primary responsibility for matters pertaining to the Bylaws and Policies, in accordance with NPA by-laws, Board approved policies and practices, and Arizona law.

1. The Bylaws/Policy Committee Chair may be selected by the Board Chair or by the members of the committee. The Bylaws/Policies Committee Chair shall bring the proposed committee membership to the Board for ratification at least once a year.
2. At least one member of this committee shall be a member of the Board of Directors.
3. Other members of this committee shall be members of the Board of Directors, NPA Administrators, other interested community members, or parents of NPA students as determined by the Board.

Responsibilities

1. Evaluate current bylaws of the Board of Directors for appropriateness and change if necessary.
2. Evaluate the current policies of the Board of Directors for appropriateness and change if necessary; including the addition of new policies as needed.
3. Annually evaluate its work as a committee and the objectives it has committed itself to, and report on the same to the Board of Directors.
