WORD OF THE DAY: dispel

Definition: to drive away, scatter (v)

To all students: AP testing is going on from May 5th until May 13th. We will need and expect cooperation from all students in minimizing noise and disruption while students are taking these important exams. Their results can affect college credits and tuition. It's VERY important that you not be a source of disruption, and we know you would not want other people disrupting you when it's your turn to take these tests. As in the past, we will have quiet zones in the areas surrounding the testing. If your locker is in the area around a test room, you may only access your locker during class changes which FOLLOW even-numbered periods. For lunch class changes, you may not be able to access your locker until near the end of lunch, so TAKE YOUR LUNCH OUT OF YOUR LOCKER IN BETWEEN 2ND AND 3RD PERIODS. Also, you may have to take detours during class changes when directed by teachers to avoid these rooms, and you are to be quiet while in the hallways at all times. Even when you do get to access your locker, don't slam your locker door. This year we have two days with afternoon exams on top of morning exams. On behalf of all the students testing, thank you in advance for your cooperation.

- The dates of tests and quiet zones are as follows:
 - Mon, 5/10: MORNING:** Testing in Room 209, and Ms. Sell's office. Quiet zone includes the entire 2nd floor. Testing should finish just after 12noon.
 - Mon, 5/10: AFTERNOON:** Testing in Ms. Sell's Office; Quiet zone includes all lockers near Mrs. Bain's room – no locker access between 5th and 6th period, but okay at 3pm (be quick & quiet).
 - Tue, 5/11: MORNING:** Testing in Rooms 202, 203, and 105; quiet zone includes all lockers in that half of 2nd floor and 1st floor lockers near Room 105 and 102. Testing in 202 & 203 should finish just after 12noon; 105 will be later.
 - Tue, 5/11: AFTERNOON:** Testing in Room 204; Quiet zone includes all lockers near Mrs. Bain's room – no locker access between 5th and 6th period, but okay at 3pm (be quick & quiet).
- **The locker lottery has taken place for choosing next year's lockers.** The results are on Mrs. Childers window at room 104. **Juniors will begin locker selection TODAY at 7:30 AM. If you are not here,** the next in line will get their locker choice before you. We will stop at 8:00am and continue locker selection **at lunch time. As soon as the juniors finish, we will start with 10th graders.** Listen to the daily announcements to see when your grade level will be selecting lockers.
- **All students and families who would like to eat on the NAU campus before graduation, we are pre-selling Hot Spot tickets.** Tickets will be available for purchase in the lobby during lunch on **Tue. May 11th** and on **Thu. May 13th**. Prices are \$9 for adults and \$8 for youth ages 5-11. Kids ages 4 and younger are free but still require a ticket. Please bring payment in the exact amount and checks may be made out to NPA. Any questions, please contact Margaret Rynn by phone.
