










# APPROPRIATE USE OF CELLPHONES AND OTHER ELECTRONIC DEVICES

- Recognizing that students often do have legitimate needs for using phones, PDAs, and other electronic devices, NPA's Administration has established rules to allow the use of such devices at appropriate times and with reasonable limits.
- This chart is not comprehensive. Just because a particular use is not listed as prohibited does not mean it is allowed.
- NPA administration reserves the right to restrict these privileges at any time as conditions or situations warrant.
- All use of the NPA network is subject to the user agreement in place and signed by students. Students who may be using their own data access must still adhere to school rules concerning appropriate content and the appropriate use of devices.
