Students taking these courses are either:

- (a) Students being required to re-take a course as a condition of moving to the next course in the math sequence,

9th graders with a D or F in Algebra I for semester 1 and/or semester 2 are required to retake Algebra I. They are strongly encouraged to take summer school, otherwise they will be placed in Algebra I next fall as sophomores and will be at risk of not meeting graduation requirements.

8th graders with a C in Algebra I for semester 1 and/or semester 2 are required to retake Algebra I. These students are encouraged to take summer school, otherwise they will be placed in Algebra I for 9th grade.

- (b) Students seeking to accelerate their long-range math sequence via a summer class and who are approved by the Math Department Chair, or

- (c) Students seeking a refresher/prep course as recommended by their current math teacher.

COSTS AND CANCELLATION:

- **The non-refundable fee for the course is payable to NPA by May 19th**. Checks are payable to “NPA” and should be given to Mrs. Kasprzyk in the administration office. Fees may also be paid online through the NPA website, but make sure to mark “Summer Session Fees” and the session name in the subject line, and still submit the registration form to Mrs. Kasprzyk (kkasprzyk@northlandprep.org).
- Class sizes may be limited. Registration will be first-come, first-served based on payment. Wait lists will be established if necessary.
- If NPA needs to cancel an offering, full refunds will be issued.

ATTENDANCE, GRADING, AND COURSE OUTCOMES:

- In such a condensed class schedule, full attendance is essential.
- Students must be present for at least 21 of the 24 days for in order to receive credit.
- If a student is unavoidably absent for a day of class, he/she must make up assignments as directed by the instructor.
- For students taking a math class to move *ahead*, the Algebra courses can earn credit that can be posted to the high school transcript. Note, however, that NPA students are required to take a math class every school year, even if that results in exceeding the four credit requirement.
- For high school students *re-taking* a math class, grades already on their high school transcript for these courses are not deleted. The new grade, however, will be posted as an addition and will be added into the student’s overall GPA. State universities typically count the higher (repeat) credit when assessing high school transcripts.
